"Not to harden my heart. Instead put my heart in Jesus' hands."


"Love is important in every relationship. If we learned to love one another the way that God loves us, the world would be a better place."

"Canadian Law Says a Baby Doesn't Become a Human Being Until She is Outside Her Mother's Body."

The report read: "Under Canada's Criminal

Code, a child becomes a human being ... when it has completely proceeded, in a living state, from the body of its mother, whether or not (a) it has breathed; (b) it has an independent circulation; or (c) the navel string is severed."

The article continued: "The legal situation really comes down to abortion activists' agenda; they readily admit that they do not want any rights to be given to babies before birth, no matter how far along in the womb they are and no matter whether their mother has them killed in an abortion or someone else commits violence against them and their mother. Abortion is legal for any reason up until birth in Canada."
