Isn't it exciting to read about 40 Days for Life moving their headquarters into an empty Planned Parenthood building?? Our God is SO incredibly faithful to answer our prayers! As this year comes to an end, we can celebrate with all that is happening to save innocent

According to the Washington Post, in March of this year: 19 abortion clinics closed in Texas. In the November edition of Bloomberg,

abortion clinics are closing in the U.S. at a record pace. In four states — Mississippi, North Dakota, South Dakota and Wyoming — just one remains. Through 2013, states had approved 205 abortion restrictions since a push began in 2011 — more than had passed in the prior decade. During that time, more than 70 clinics closed or stopped offering the procedure.
