
2018 Race for Life

Volunteer Spotlight: Sue Howard, Class Instructor



"I have been a volunteer with AAA since 2011. I first learned of the Center at a worship/outreach event I attended at Connection Church in Canton. (It was the only time I attended one of their events.). I had previously attended a women's ministry seminar in Grand Rapids where one of the classes I attended was on the huge mission field working with abortion minded women and post abortion women. Since I had been looking for ministry opportunities, I knew it was definitely a "God thing" that I attended that event that night and that Jan was there representing the Center and their work. I'm pretty sure I signed up that night.

After orientation and training, I started my work at the Center as an associate, working with clients on a one on one basis. Some of the women I saw were in crisis with an unexpected pregnancy who were looking for answers, resources, education, and sometimes just someone who would listen without judgement and show them kindness and love. Others came in to join our material goods program and enroll in classes.

While I loved meeting with our clients and helping them make decisions about their baby's future, I soon realized I wanted to establish more long-term relationships with some of our women. I began teaching classes. While I pray I am a blessing for the women who attend, watching them learn their worth in God's eyes and how precious they are to Him and His plan for their lives has been a huge blessing to me. I have taught several different classes- parenting, personal growth, relational, and God's plan for sexuality & marriage - to name just a few.

There are many ways God has worked in my life through volunteering at the Center. One is the friendships I have made with the other people who work/volunteer at the Center. They have been a huge influence & made a big impact in my life. And I still hear from some of our clients who have graduated from the program. I am humbled and honored that God has seen fit to use me in this ministry."

On Tuesday, 6/26/2018, The U.S. Supreme Court handed down a 5-4 ruling in the NIFLA v. Becerra case, overturning the coercive law that forced pro-life pregnancy centers to provide free advertising for tax-funded abortions! (See case study below.)

Also, on Tuesday, 6/26/2018, another important supreme court announcement: The retirement of supreme court Justice Anthony Kennedy.

Our walk with the Lord includes all seasons. Sometimes, in the work that we are called to do, it can appear that our enemies have the upper hand. WE know that the real battle belongs to the Lord and He will bring the victory.

Peggy Roberts Executive Director NIFLA v. Becerra Case Summary

In 2015 California passed AB 775, the socalled "Reproductive FACT Act." This law mandates that medical pro-life pregnancy centers provide written or digital information to their patients - such as a sign in the waiting room - on how to obtain a state-funded abortion. This means that nonprofit pro-life medical clinics as well as their staff and volunteers are being forced to violate their consciences - an outright violation of their First Amendment rights.

In defense of the 150 California pregnancy centers that it represents, NIFLA filed a lawsuit challenging this legislation. Arquments for this landmark pro-life free speech case were heard by the U.S. Supreme Court on March 20, 2018.
