

## **STATEMENT OF FAITH**

Guided by the principle “In Essentials, Unity; in Non-Essentials, Liberty; in All things, Love,” the AAA Pregnancy Resource Center, an inter-denominational Christian ministry, affirms the following as faith essentials.

**ABOUT SCRIPTURE:** We believe that the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are inspired of God, are inerrant and infallible in whole and in part as written by the Biblical writers. The Bible is altogether true because it is revelation from God (2 Pet. 1:20-21; 2 Tim. 3:14-17).

**ABOUT THE TRINITY:** We believe that God is one in essence, but eternally existent in three Persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. As God, each is worthy of our personal worship and honor (Matt. 28:19; John 17:5; John 6:27; Heb. 1:1-13).

**ABOUT JESUS CHRIST:** We believe that Jesus Christ was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, and is true God and true man yet without sin. We believe in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory (John 1:1-14; Matt. 1:18; Luke 1:26-38; 2 Thess. 1:7).

**ABOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT:** We believe that the Holy Spirit convicts the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment. He enables the believer to live a godly life. (John 16:7-11; 1Cor. 12:13; Gal. 5:16; John 15:26-27; Eph. 5:15-21; Phi. 1:6).

**ABOUT MANKIND:** We believe that mankind was created in the image of God, making him responsible to God (Gen. 1:27; Isa. 43:7; James 3:9). All human beings are born with an inherited sin nature (Rom 5:12-21). We believe that each person is resurrected, to live eternally either with God, or absent from God (1 Thess. 4:13-18; Rev. 20:11-15; John 14:1-6; Heb. 1:10-14, Luke 16:19-31).

**ABOUT SALVATION:** We believe that all who believe in and rely upon the Lord Jesus Christ for their salvation receive new life by the working of the Holy Spirit, and thereby become children of God and heirs of eternal life (Eph.2: 8-10; John 3:7-8; 2 Pet. 1:4; 2 Cor. 5:17).

**ABOUT DENOMINATIONS:** There are many Christian denominations represented among our volunteers, staff and supporters. We at AAA PRC agree to work together in unity to uphold the sanctity of human life (Eph. 4:1-7).
