

AAA Pregnancy Resource Center Statement of Principle

AAA PRC board members, directors, staff, and volunteers are Christians. We believe that God is One in essence, but eternally existent in three Persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Isa. 44:6, Matt. 28:19). We represent many denominations.

- We believe that the right to life is endowed by the Creator at the time of conception and is an inalienable right. All human life is meaningful and precious from conception until natural death (Gen. 1:26-28, Jer. 1:4-5). Abortion is a transgression of divine principles (Ex. 20:13), but Jesus Christ offers forgiveness and restoration to all individuals who have been involved in an abortion through confession and repentance (John 20:22-23, Luke 18:13-14, 19:7-10).
- We believe in total abstinence and chastity for single men and women.
- We believe that marriage is between one man and one woman.
- The PRC is committed to providing its clients with accurate and complete information about both prenatal development and abortion.
- Our first responsibility to a client is to be a caring listener and to help with an unplanned pregnancy. If open to discussing spiritual needs, we will initiate that conversation.
- The PRC does not recommend, provide, or refer for abortion.
- The PRC is committed to educating the local community regarding healthy relationships, the challenges of unplanned pregnancies, and that abortion compounds the problem rather than resolving it.
- The PRC does not recommend, provide, or refer for contraceptives or abortifacients. (Abortifacients are methods of birth control that may permit fertilization but contribute to the destruction of the unborn child i.e. IUD, birth control pills, patch, or shot).
- The PRC neither initiates nor facilitates independent adoptions, but recognizes the validity of adoptions as an alternative to abortion.
- The PRC does not discriminate in providing services because of race, religion, color, national origin, age, disability, or marital status of its clients.
- The PRC offers services free of charge.
