Abortion Pill Warning

By promoting medical abortion, big pharmaceutical companies are now cashing in while women are further separated from genuine health care. In the absence of a doctor's care, abortion pills are simply not safe. Nationally, Mifepristone has been associated with dozens of deaths and hundreds of life-threatening complications that we know of .

Expanding "abortion care" has been preferred over women's health. Accessible "abortion care" without common sense safety measures is not care at all.

AAAAPRC has a long history as a trusted confidential non-profit that provides resources and medical services to families touched by an unplanned pregnancy. Early ultrasound, and accurate gestational dating by highly qualified staff intervene at the earliest days of a pregnancy.




